When Starmer went to the White House, he issued an invitation to Trump from the King. We don't yet know the date of Trump's visit, but we need to be ready to protest when he comes!

Trump has attacked the rights of women, LGBTQ+ people and other minority groups, and supports the mass deportation of migrants. He has bragged about helping billionaires get even richer, all while millions of Americans live in poverty.

Socialist Students is putting out the call for Trump to be met by a massive youth walkout on 'Day X' – the day he visits Parliament, which we will know closer to the time. We can start to prepare now, by organising meetings in our schools, colleges and universities on how we can protest and build the walkouts. Let's get ready to show Trump that we reject him and his politics of exploitation and division!

Just like Trump in the US, Starmer has nothing to offer young people here in Britain. His Labour government has raised university tuition fees, cut disability benefits for young people, and allowed the closure of even more youth clubs and mental health services.

By attacking our living standards and denying us a decent future, Starmer wants to keep money in the pockets of the super-rich. Like Trump, Starmer's Labour Party defends capitalism – a global system that produces massive profits for a tiny few, while creating wars, poverty, and climate destruction for the rest of us.

To distract from the failure of capitalism to give us a future, Starmer has tried to scapegoat migrants and trans people instead. Nigel Farage and his Reform UK party are no different – as well as attacking migrants, they have pledged to ban so-called 'trans ideology' from schools.

By building the biggest possible youth walkouts when Trump comes to Britain, we can send a defiant message not just to Trump, but to Starmer, Farage and all the capitalist politicians who stand between us and a future free from exploitation and division.

We can also send a powerful message to young people in America that we

stand with them against Trump – not with Starmer and the Labour government that has rolled out the red carpet for him.

We know there is enough wealth in society for all young people to have a free and properly funded education, a decent home, and a well-paid job to look forward to. But we need to build a mass movement that fights to take this wealth out of the hands of the capitalist bosses – a movement that unites all young and working-class people, whatever our background, in a common struggle against their division and exploitation.

If the world's wealth and resources were in the hands of the working-class majority, then society could be planned to meet the needs of all people, not the profits of a tiny few. That would be a socialist world based on working-class unity, collaboration, and international solidarity. It would lay the foundation for a world free of all of exploitation, war and inequality.

1. Organise a meeting at your school, college or university!
